

KNOW YOUR WATER METER

The 2-minute check every homeowner should know.

Many homeowners know where their electricity meter is. Far fewer know where their water meter is - or how to use it to identify a hidden leak.

Here's a simple test:

- 1 Turn off all taps, appliances and water-using fixtures around the home.
- 2 Locate your water meter (usually near the front boundary).
- 3 Check if the meter is still moving.

If the meter is moving...

You may have a hidden water leak

Common causes include:

- Underground water service leaks
- Leaking toilets
- Dripping taps
- Irrigation leaks
- Faulty valves



TOM'S TIP

A small leak can waste thousands of litres of water before it's ever noticed. If your water bill suddenly increases, your water meter is one of the first places to check.

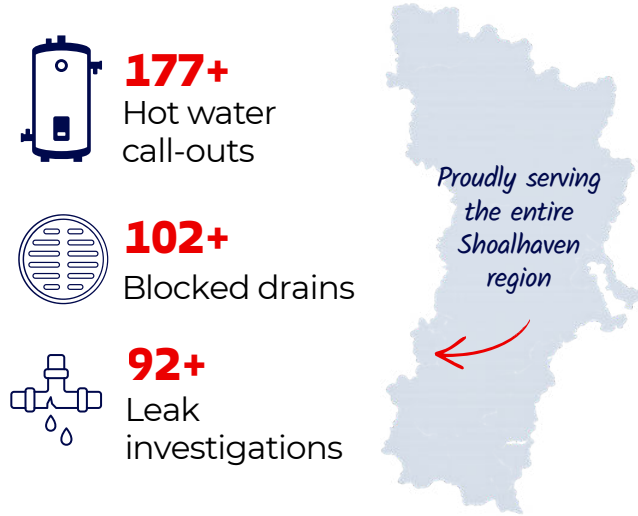

HEAVY RAIN WARNING SIGNS

Winter rain places extra pressure on drains and stormwater systems.

After winter rain, keep an eye out for:

- Water pooling around your home
- Soggy patches that stay wet
- Overflowing stormwater pits
- Water backing up during heavy rain
- Slow draining outdoor areas

IS YOUR HOT WATER SYSTEM READY FOR WINTER?

Winter is when ageing hot water systems work their hardest.

Warning signs we commonly see:

- Running out of hot water sooner
- Fluctuating water temperatures
- Leaks around the system
- Rust stains
- Strange noises

DID YOU KNOW?

Many emergency winter hot water replacements have been showing warning signs for months beforehand.

TOM'S TIP

Take a walk around your home after the next decent rainfall. Any water that isn't getting away properly is usually worth investigating before the next storm arrives.

5 MINUTE WINTER PLUMBING CHECK

Walk around your home with this checklist after the next decent rainfall. Winter rain often reveals plumbing issues that aren't noticeable during drier months.

- ☐ Hot water system looks dry
- ☐ No rust around fittings
- ☐ Stormwater pits drain freely
- ☐ No water pooling after rain
- ☐ Outdoor taps aren't dripping
- ☐ No unexplained increase in water bills
- ☐ Know where your water meter is
